

Millennium bim “A Clean City For Me”

The project "A Clean City For Me", developed within the social responsibility program of Millennium bim "More Mozambique for me", in five years of activity engaged more than nine thousand young people.

Launched in 2007, with the purpose of raise awareness among civil society to the importance of maintain public spaces cleaned and preserved, has promoted several activities in which many young people have been involved, creating consciousness in good habits from early ages.

The project, until now, has been developed with the participation of students from secondary and primary schools, of the cities of Maputo, Matola and Tete, and was materialized in the improvement and maintenance of public spaces through: street cleaning, beaches cleaning, gardens rehabilitation, painting of schools walls, among other activities. The activities are carried out along with teachers and representatives of the neighborhoods.
